

Personal Profile: Phil Kemp

Since October 2007 Phil has been Head of OGC's Gateway™ Brand Assurance team, managing the OGC Gateway™ Brand across the UK public sector and international user community. This work includes leading on the governance and development strategy for the product, helping new users adopt the product, managing its quality assurance process and for dealing with related Intellectual Property and Trade Mark issues. Phil also has responsibility for managing the UK's OGC Gateway training contract. Phil is an accredited high risk project Gateway review team member.

Between 2004 and 2007 Phil was Head of Assurance in the Home Office's programme and project management centre of excellence, with responsibility for managing OGC Gateway reviews, Health-check evaluations and other project assurance activities within the department and its associated organisations.

Between 2000 and 2004 Phil was the Programme Manager for the Infrastructure and Support Services and Head of the Programme Management Office for the development of the UK's National Technical Assistance Centre (NTAC). After NTAC became operational Phil managed the organisation's business management unit.

Prior to working on the NTAC programme Phil had been an Internal Auditor for over 20 years, working in three government departments undertaking audit reviews and advising major projects on risk, control and audit matters. This included being the Home Office's Senior Internal Auditor with responsibility for audits of change programmes and ICT projects and Head of Internal Audit for the Police IT Organisation.

Outside work Phil is an aviation historian and photographer and is Director of an annual aviation show/event. He is Vice Chairman of Air-Britain, the world largest aviation historians association.
