- Students mastering a high level of fluency in English (oral and written). Knowledge of an Asian language, in particular Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Romansh or Nepali, is an asset;
- Students with proof of academic excellence, in particular regarding analysis and research of political and international affairs or security and disarmament matters. Knowledge of the Asia-Pacific region would be an asset.

The purpose of the unpaid internships is to complement and enhance the academic education of the intern through professional work assignments with UNRCPD; expose the intern to the activities and goals of UNRCPD and of the United Nations in general; and to provide UNRCPD with the assistance of qualified students specialized in politics, international affairs or security matters.
