### **Announcement of Research Associates Program**

The Asian International Economists Network (AIEN) is an open network of international economic policy experts and scholars in Asia. It was established as a resource for policy makers involved in trade negotiations and policy debates.

AIEN is recruiting four Research Associates (RAs) to produce research work on trade and/or macro related topics including but not limited to structural transformation, trade finance, production networks, and logistics and connectivity. RAs are expected to write one to two short policy briefs on trade related issues and a longer paper suitable for journal publication. RAs will also contribute regular blog posts on current trade topics to the AIEN website. They will also work on preparing for conferences and seminars.

Contracts will be offered for a period of 6 to 9 months starting June 2012. RAs will work at the Asian Development Bank headquarters in Manila, Philippines.

**Requirements:** Candidates should at least have a Master's degree in economics, international relations or international law with a focus on trade. They should have a minimum of 2 years work experience or be enrolled in a PhD program. The candidate should have excellent writing and technical assessment skills, and extensive experience in writing academic papers and reports.
