

## LKYSPP Study Trip in Japan



In February 2013 students of Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, National University of Singapore (LKYSPP) are coming to Japan to conduct a week-long study trip. We are looking for GraSPP students who are interested in joining this trip.

### Synopsis

The purpose of the trip is to provide opportunity for students of LKYSPP and GraSPP to study Japanese public policy through discussions and sight visit to actual stakeholders in the field of Japanese public policy, e.g. ministries, local governments, NGOs and relevant business enterprises.

There will be funding available for students who help prepare the trip, which will be covering the major cost of the trip. This will also serve as a great opportunity to do networking between two top schools of Asia involving major actors of public policy in Japan.

### Tentative Schedule

**February 24:** LKY-GraSPP Day (Student workshop)

**February 25:** Visits to ministries and corporations (staying in Tokyo)

**February 26:** Visits to ministries and corporations (staying in Tokyo)

**February 27:** Visits to Local governments in Kanto region and move to Nanto city, Toyama Prefecture (staying in Nanto City)

**February 28:** Visits to Nanto City hall and Gokayama World Heritage sights (staying in Nanto City)

**March 1:** Visits to local government in Kanazawa city, Ishikawa Prefecture and move to Kyoto (staying in Kyoto)

**March 2:** Final wrap up session/meeting (staying in Kyoto)

**March 3:** End of Program

**Eligibility**

- All current and incoming students of the University of Tokyo
- Participants are required to help prepare for the program in order to get financial assistance for the program. For example, we will ask you to help us prepare for LKY-GraSPP Day.

**Number of Positions: 10**

If we receive more than 10 applications, we will consult the participants to adjust the number after closing the application.

**Cost**

Accommodation and transportation outside of Tokyo will be funded by the program.
