Synopsis

There will be funding available for students who help prepare the trip, which will be covering the major cost of the trip. This will also serve as a great opportunity to do networking between two top schools of Asia involving major actors of public policy in Japan.

March 1: Final wrap up session/meeting (staying in Kyoto)
March 2: End of Program

Eligibility

All current and incoming students of GraSPP. Participants are required to help preparing for the program. For example, we will ask you to help us prepare for LKY-GraSPP Day.

Number of Positions

7 students.

If we receive more than 7 applications, we will consult the participants to adjust the number after closing the application. (Ability to speak both Japanese and English is preferred.)

\mathbf{Cost}

Accommodation and transportation outside of Tokyo will be funded by the program. Transportation after the program (from Kyoto to Tokyo) is covered.
