1. Eligibility:

Students, faculty and administrative staff of the University (those who possess staff or student ID cards issued by the University of Tokyo).

2. Dates and Times:

December, 8 (Thu) 12:30 – 14:00 Students and staff members

December, 9 (Fri) 13:00 – 14:00 First come, first served

**\* The vaccination ends as soon as the present stock has run out.**

3. Location:

Hongo Health Service Center

4. Fee:

Students – JPY 2,500 Staff members– JPY 3,000 \* We only accept cash.

(We have the exact amount when paying. If change is required, it is possible that you will be required to wait.)

5. Reservation:

December, 1 (Thu) 10:00 - midnight (12:00hrs) of December, 7(Wed)

\*Please be aware that reservations cannot be made by telephone.

6. What to bring on the day:

1) Completed influenza vaccination form

- Download the form from the website <http://www.hc.u-tokyo.ac.jp/>, print it double-sided and fill in the necessary information and bring with you on the day.
- Take your temperature and fill in the information on the form.
- ~~Signature of parents or guardians will be required by underaged minors.~~

2) Staff or student ID card issued by the University of Tokyo.

3) Vaccination fee: JPY 2,500 for students, JPY 3,000 for staff (cash only and please bring exact change)

4) Printed reservation information from the website. (Screen print, memo or photo image of screen is accepted) \*only for December, 8

\*You need to bring all as noted above, otherwise you cannot be vaccinated.

7. Other important information:

- 1) You will receive an interview from a physician on the day of the vaccination. Please note that depending on the diagnosis given by the doctor you may not be given the vaccination.
- 2) Please read the “Key Facts about Influenza (Flu) & Flu Vaccine ” manual carefully before your visit.
- 3) People who experience heavy secondary reactions after vaccinations cannot be inoculated at the health center.
- 4) Please make sure to come promptly. If you are late for your appointment, your reservation will be cancelled.
- 5) Please refrain from making telephone inquiries regarding the vaccination.
