

## Important Notes and Additional Eligibility Requirements for Scholarships

### 1. For Asia Development Bank-Japan Scholarship Program (ADB-JSP) and Joint Japan / World Bank Graduate School Program (JJ/WBGSP)

All dates and times are based on Japan Standard Time.

### Important Notes

[Both ADB-JSP and JJ/WBGSP]

- Decisions on scholarship awards will be made independently by ADB and WB. Scholarship nominees, who will be chosen from applicants offered admission to GraSPP, are required to complete the application procedures instructed by ADB and/or WB scholarships respectively. In order to process the scholarship nomination, the MPP/IP Desk will share the applicants' personal information with ADB and WB regardless of the provision of 11. Miscellaneous (3) on the Application Guidelines 2020.

[ADB-JSP only]

- ADB scholarship nominees will be required to submit the scholarship application, which includes the financial certificate to the MPP/IP Desk within several days after the scholarship nomination.
- The scholarship results will be announced by GraSPP.

[JJ/WBGSP only]

- WB scholarship nominees will be required to complete WB online application, which includes two letters of reference from their professional supervisors, by the deadline set by WB (approximately ten days).
- The scholarship awardees will be announced by WB .

<sup>2</sup>Original official application documents: C, D, I, K, M, and N. See Appendix 1. The MPP/IP Desk does not respond to inquiries of individual delivery status.

<sup>3</sup> Interview schedules will be notified as well at this time.

<sup>4</sup> Applicants who are invited to an interview are required to be available on the scheduled date and time. The designated date and time are not negotiable.

<sup>5</sup> Not all scholarship nominees can be awarded the scholarships.

## Eligibility for Asia Development Bank-Japan Scholarship Program (ADB-JSP)

Eligibility requirements for ADB include:

- a national of an ADB borrowing member country;
- at least two (2) years of full time professional working experience (acquired after a university degree) at the time of application.

## Eligibility for Joint Japan / World Bank Graduate School Program (JJ/WBGSP)

Eligibility requirements for WB include:

- a national of a World Bank member developing country;
- not a holder of a dual citizenship of a developed country;
- at least three (3) years or more of recent paid development-related experience after earning a bachelor's or equivalent degree;
- being employed in a paid and fulltime position at the time of application.

## 2. For Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship (University Recommendation) - International Priority Graduate Program: MEXT (PGP)

### Important Notes

- The name of MEXT (PGP) at GraSPP is Global Public Policy Professional Development Program.
- An applicant who is a national of an ASEAN country is prioritized.
- An applicant, who passed the document screening of MPP/IP, is eligible to apply for MEXT (PGP).
- The details of the scholarship eligibility and application procedures will be posted at the beginning of January 2020 on our website below.

- The Scholarship selection will be conducted independently by MEXT. The final scholarship results will be announced by MEXT around the end of June 2020.
- In order to process the scholarship nomination, the MPP/IP Desk will share the applicants' personal information with the International Student Adviser at GraSPP regardless of the provision of 11. Miscellaneous (3) on the Application Guidelines 2020.

## 3. For CAMPUS Asia Program

### Important Note

- The CAMPUS Asia Program is a student exchange / double degree program between Peking University, Seoul National University and the University of Tokyo. Japanese nationals and Korean nationals with Japan's special permanent residence visa are highly encouraged to apply for this option.
- Chinese citizens are not eligible to participate in the CAMPUS Asia Program from UTokyo due to the Peking University's policy.
