Influenza vaccination on all three campuses are by reservation. Reservations opens from October, 30(Mon) 10 : 00 am, 2017 and can be made through the following website: <u>http://www.hc.u-tokyo.ac.jp/</u>.

The login information can be obtained on the screen after you log onto the screen after you log onto UTAS(UTokyo Academic affairs System). The Common ID is the 18-digit number printed on the bottom right hand corner of your ID Card.

4. Fee:

Students – JPY 2,500 Staff members– JPY 3,000 (Cash only)

5. Reservation:

Students: From October, 30(Mon) 10 : 00 am ~ midnight (12:00hrs) of the day before your desired date Staff: From November, 2(Thu) 10 : 00 am~ midnight (12:00hrs) of the day before your desired date % Please be aware that reservations cannot be made by telephone.

X Staff members will not be able to make reservations during the students' reservation period.

6. What to bring on the day:

- 1) Completed influenza vaccination form
 - Download the form from the website <u>http://www.hc.u-tokyo.ac.jp/.</u> print it double-sided and fill in the necessary information and bring with you on the day.
 - Take your temperature and fill in the information on the form.
 - <u>Signature of parents or guardians will be required by under-aged minors (anyone under the age of 20).</u>
- 2) Staff or student ID card issued by the University of Tokyo.
- 3) Vaccination fee: JPY 2,500 for students, JPY 3,000 for staff (Cash only)
 - Please make sure to the exact amount when paying.
- 4) Printed reservation information from the website.
 - Screen print, memo or photo image of screen is accepted.

*You need to bring 1) - 4) as noted above, otherwise you will not be able to receive the vaccination.

7. Other important information:

- As you may already know, the arrival of influenza vaccination available is expected to get behind than usual, which will affect the scheduling and the amount of the vaccinations which we are able to provide. We thank you for your understanding in advance.
- You will receive an interview from a physician on the day of the vaccination. Please note that depending on the diagnosis given by the doctor you may not be given the vaccination.
- Please read the "Key Facts about Influenza (Flu) & Flu Vaccine" manual carefully before your visit.
- People who experience heavy secondary reactions after vaccinations cannot be inoculated at the health center.
- Please make sure to come promptly.
