When and where

If you want to participate ...

- Submit an application with your proposal as instructed.
- Only those who have passed selection process based on the proposal, and interview as needed, are allowed to register during the A2 registration period (November 28 to December 4).

If you want to participate ... (continued)

- Students who have participated in the past IFWs could apply again and might be admitted, but will not earn credits.
- The number of students allowed to participate will be limited to up to about ten due to the nature of the course involving a series of intensive on-site discussions.

Please note that the course grade will be available only after early March 2018. Students in their final semester of studies should not take this course to earn credits required for completion. The credits earned in this course are NOT counted as credits for completion.
