The applicant must have sufficient communication skills, both writing and speaking, in English—native English speaker or non-native with iBT95/ CBT240/ IELTS 7.0 or above. 3. The applicant must have a <u>well prepared research plan on a topic, which would serve IIMA's research agenda</u>, such as issues relating to the international economic, financial and currency matters. The student selected as intern is <u>expected to complete a research paper, possibly as a joint paper with IIMA economists, during the internship.</u>
Comments from the institution	A highly-motivated student, who could deliver during the internship his/her own research outcome on issues in line with IIMA's priorities, would be welcome. IIMA economists will give advice and support as needed to help advance the intern's research project.
