授業のキーワード Keywords	<p><b>The Challenge</b></p> <p>We are inviting students to identify an important policy challenge in any public policy field and in any regional, international or national context. Students should form teams between 3 and 5 members and work together to develop their proposals. Each school of the GPPN will send up to 20 students in total.</p> <p>We are looking for student presentations on public policy proposals that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify a an important and pressing public policy problem;</li> <li>• Present a convincing and innovative solution and demonstrate why this proposal is appropriate to solve the policy problem identified;</li> <li>• Explain how the solution shall be implemented and what implementation challenges will need to be overcome, taking into account available knowledge and the context in which the policy challenge occurs.</li> </ul> <p>The proposal should be concise but clearly argued and based on evidence from practice and/or research.</p>
