

Oxford Kobe Scholarships 2005–2006

Two Oxford Kobe Scholarships will be available for students of Japanese nationality taking up places to study for a graduate degree at the University of Oxford in October 2005. Candidates should be completing, or have already completed, a first degree course (Bachelor's degree) and have sufficient competence in English.

The scholarships may be held for study in any subject area. The scholarships will cover full University and college fees and provide a maintenance grant for accommodation and living expenses. In addition, scholarships will meet the cost of travel to and from the UK at the start and end of the course.

The closing date for completed scholarship applications to reach the University is 31 December 2004. Candidates for the scholarship must also apply to the University for admission to their proposed course of study. You should apply for admission in the first gathered field if possible, or if not in the second gathered field as explained in the online prospectus at www.admin.ox.ac.uk/gsp. Candidates who are short-listed for the scholarships will be interviewed by a selection committee in Japan at the end of February or beginning of March 2005.
