

IMF Tokyo Office – Summer Internship Program

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific, based in Tokyo, is accepting applications for several Internships during summer 2007. The Internships are intended to provide graduate students with an opportunity to experience working for an international organization and learn about the IMF.

The period of the internship will be **6–8 weeks** during **July-September 2007**. A daily stipend will be provided to the Summer Interns as remuneration.

The following three Summer Intern positions will be open to the qualified candidates:

- Economist Interns (2 positions) : Work closely with IMF economists on a current research topic.
- External Relations (EXR) Intern: Work with the external relations manager on projects related to public affairs/outreach.
