Former Prime Minister of the Republic of Korea

Former President and Professor of Economics, Seoul National University

Formerly the president of Seoul National University (SNU), his alma mater, Dr. Chung was appointed the 40th prime minister of the Republic of Korea effective September 29, 2009. After receiving a doctoral degree in economics from Princeton University in 1978, he served as a professor in the Faculty of Economics at SNU until September 2009. During his academic and administrative career before appointment as the prime minister, Dr. Chung also taught economics at Columbia University, University of Hawaii, London School of Economics, and Ruhr-Universität Bochum and held senior advisory positions on government commissions and at private research institutions in Korea. In addition, he was the president of the Korean Economic Association in 2006 and the founding director of the SNU Institute for Research in Finance and Economics from 2008 to 2009. Dr. Chung was appointed as the 23rd president of SNU in 2002 and served honorably until 2006.
