Qualification of Applicants

- Applicants for Master programs should have a Bachelor degree.
- (2) Applicants for PhD programs should have a Master degree.(3) Language skills requirements:
- (a) For programs taught in Chinese: the applicants for programs of humanities, arts, management, journalism and law should pass Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 6 or new HSK band 5-score 180, and those for science and engineering programs should pass Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or new HSK band 4-score 195.

For applicants who do not have adequate Chinese language skills but meet academic requirements of admission, intensive Chinese training courses are required in the first one or two semesters to help them pass HSK test.

- (b) For Master Programs offered in English: See the requirements of the programs.
- (c) For PhD program applicants: If the English level is sufficient, the Chinese language requirement could be adjusted for some majors.




