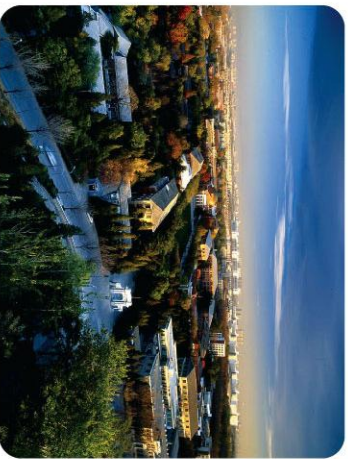


## Qualification of Applicants

- (1) Applicants for Master programs should have a Bachelor degree.
- (2) Applicants for PhD programs should have a Master degree.
- (3) Language skills requirements:
  - (a) For programs taught in Chinese: the applicants for programs of humanities, arts, management, journalism and law should pass Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 6 or new HSK band 5-score 180, and those for science and engineering programs should pass Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or new HSK band 4-score 195.
  - (b) For applicants who do not have adequate Chinese language skills but meet academic requirements of admission, intensive Chinese training courses are required in the first one or two semesters to help them pass HSK test.
  - (c) For Master Programs offered in English: See the requirements of the programs.
  - (d) For PhD program applicants: If the English level is sufficient, the Chinese language requirement could be adjusted for some majors.

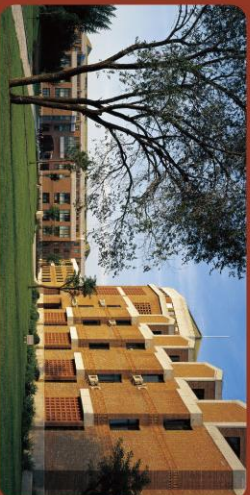

## Introduction

Tsinghua University is widely acknowledged as one of the most prestigious universities that hold the greatest strengths in China. Over the years, it has been ranked first in China in the numbers of academicians affiliated with the Chinese Academy of Science and the Chinese Academy of Engineering, of the top national awards in science and technology, of research funds, and also of articles indexed in SCI, EI and ISTP.

Currently, Tsinghua University consists of 15 schools with 55 departments. The total number of full-time students is 31,643, including 14,608 undergraduates and 17,035 postgraduates. The University offers 65 bachelor's degree programs, 199 master's degree programs and 182 Ph.D. programs, which cover a variety of academic fields such as sciences, engineering, humanities and arts, history, philosophy, economics, management, law, education and medicine.

Tsinghua University has been active in promoting the internationalization of student education. In the Fall of 2010, more than 3,200 international students from 122 nations are studying at Tsinghua, and nearly 1,100 of them are graduate students. In the academic year 2011-2012, the University will be offering 94 Master's and 65 Doctoral programs to international students.
