-Class format may change in accordance with [UTokyo Current Activity Restriction Level](#). If any changes occur, it will be notified through Courses 2022-2023 and student bulletin board.

-Policy below are for courses offered at GraSPP, which has course code starting with “51”. Courses offered at other faculties and graduate schools may be conducted under different policy.

Class Format at GraSPP as of March 18, 2022

- **Classes will be held mainly in-person/online.**
- **Some courses may conduct only online class.**
- **Courses may shift to in-person class based on each course’s decision and participant’s situation. Note that the transition to in-person class will occur after the course registration correction period.**
- **Classroom is used in normal capacity.**

【IMPORTANT】 5 patterns of Course delivery modalities

Patterns	Notes for taking the course.
Face-to-face: All classes conducted in-person on campus	Course offered at GraSPP will be conducted in-person/online. Course may shift to in-person class after course registration correction period.
Hybrid Type A(Face-to-face/Online): Conduct classes in-person 50% or more of the total hours of the course	
Hybrid Type B(Face-to-face/Online): Conduct classes in-person for less than 50% of the total hours of the course	
Fully Online: All classes conducted online	Conducted only online
Fully On-demand: All classes conducted on-demand	Conducted on-demand

◎For those who cannot take class in-person for unavoidable reasons

If you cannot attend class in the classroom for any unavoidable reason, please let the course instructor know.
Note that no request is required for classes conducted exclusively online.
