



- Be active, on- and off-campus, to broaden your horizons.





Double Degree Programs

- Can obtain **degrees from both the UTokyo and partner university** upon satisfying the graduation requirements of both degrees.
- A system where a student works for two different university degrees in parallel, completing them in less time (2 to 3 years) than it would take to earn them separately.



Notes for Double Degree Program 2

- New system in Sciences Po-GraSPP DD has started in 2016
 - Sciences Po has launched Master of Public Policy.
 - Joint Admission: around 10 from the world for cohort 2017-2019
 - Everyone must directly apply for Sciences Po-GraSPP DD on-line at Sciences Po's website by March 1st, 2017.
 - Start at Sciences Po in the 1st year, finish the 2nd year at UTokyo (for April enrollees: UTokyo-Sciences Po-UTokyo).
 - Strengthen the bond by maximizing the time together.
