# Application Guidelines

### < AY2023 February >

#### 1. Eligibility

1. Students enrolled in Master of Public Policy at GraSPP, or scheduled to be enrolled from April or September 2024
2. TOEFL iBT 88 or above
3. Japanese nationality or Korean nationality with special permanent resident status (other nationalities are subject to consultation※)

※Since the CAMPUS Asia Program is a CJK-ASEAN student exchange program, we especially encourage participation by Japanese and Korean nationals with special permanent resident status. Students of Chinese nationality are not eligible to study at Peking University.

#### 2. Period of Study Abroad and Options

The following study abroad options which begin in the spring of 2025 or later are available (see Appendix for details)

1. Double Degree at Peking University (PKUDD) + Exchange Program at Seoul National University (SNUEX)
2. Double Degree at Seoul National University (SNUDD)+ Exchange Program at Peking University (PKUEX)
3. Double Degree at National University of Singapore (LKYDD) + Exchange Program at Seoul National University or Peking University (SNUEX or PKUEX)
4. Exchange Program at Peking University (PKUEX) + Exchange Program at Seoul National University (SNUEX)

※Double degree (2 semesters) + exchange (1 semester), or exchange (1 semester) + exchange (1 semester).

※First year must be taken at GraSPP and dispatched from the second year onwards. The minimum enrollment period at GraSPP is 2 years and the maximum is 3 years, including the period of study abroad.

※Please contact us individually if you wish to apply for other study abroad options.

※Please note that students of Chinese nationality are not permitted to study at Peking University.

#### 3. Financial Support

1. Scholarship through the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) Overseas Study Support Program  
※There are various conditions for receiving this benefit, such as nationality, academic performance standards, and infectious disease risk level. It is also subject to change from year to year. This scholarship is granted only while studying at the host university on site (taking courses online is not applicable). Details will be provided to eligible participants.
2. Dormitories provided by the host university (except LKY)
3. Tuition waiver at the host university (except LKYDD)

**※Important: Please note that the above financial support will apply to study abroad programs that begin by the end of March 2026 under the current Mode 2; it has not yet been determined whether the same support will continue for study abroad programs that begin in April 2026 or later.**

1. Application form
2. TOEFL official score report (certified within two years, photocopy acceptable)
3. Latest academic transcript (Japanese or English, photocopy acceptable)
4. Statement of purpose (English, 500~800words)
5. Passport copy (photo page)

Interview Date:	March 4, 2024, p.m.

※If you choose PKUDD, please note that you need to apply to Peking University right after the result is announced.

#### 7. Notes

- ◆ Successful applicants will need to submit the following documents to the host universities, please consider preparing as soon as possible. Please note as the procedures may change from year to year, the latest information will be communicated to the students as soon as the host university announces an opening.

- Recommendation Letters (1 or 2) ※SNU has a designated format.
- Academic Transcripts (Undergraduate and Graduate, in English)
- Certificate of Highest Degree Attained (Certificate of Undergraduate Diploma or Graduate School Enrollment, in English)
- Application Form (designated forms)
- ID Photos

※Students may not apply concurrently with other study abroad programs.

※The final decision on whether or not to accept a student for study abroad is left to each host university.


- ◆ Students who pass the selection process at GraSPP will join the program as CAMPUS Asia students and are required to take the "CAMPUS Asia Joint Course: International Public Policy in East Asia" (2 credits each for S and A semester). Although it is advised to take the course(s) before studying abroad, please plan according to your own period of study and enrollment.

- ◆ When studying abroad, students are required to purchase the GAKKENSAN overseas study insurance (Futaikaigaku) specified for this program (insurance premium of approximately 30,000-50,000 yen for one semester of study abroad, to be paid by the student).

Features	<p>Peking University is one of the first national key universities established in 1898 as a national university. As China's premier institution of higher learning, it has produced many politicians and scientists. It is also adjacent to Zhongguancun, China's Silicon Valley, where numerous IT industries and research centers are located.</p> <p>The School of International Studies accepts students with a solid foundation in their undergraduate major and a desire to actively study Chinese diplomacy and international relations. The "Master of International Relations" course, to which students studying abroad under the CAMPUS Asia program belong, is small, with a maximum of 20 students per academic year, and combines theory and practice, allowing students to learn in English about politics, diplomacy, and social development in modern China in depth. It is also possible to earn a master's degree from Peking University if you fulfill the requirements for earning the required credits, writing a research paper, and passing an oral examination.</p>

Kim Young-sam (14th President), Kim Jong-guk (11th and 31st State Ministers), Ban Ki-moon (8th Secretary General of the United Nations), and Yun Si-yeol (20th President) are also graduates of Seoul National University.</p> <p>The Graduate School of International Studies offers a curriculum that balances advanced knowledge with the practical skills to apply it, with the aim of fostering leaders who can lead a rapidly and complex globalized society. The school train students for academic and practical careers in a wide range of fields, including bureaucracies, international organizations, research institutes, think tanks, multinational corporations, media, and universities.
