

# GraSPP CAMPUS Asia Plus **Application Guidelines**

## < AY2022 October >

#### 1. Eligibility

- 1. Students enrolled in Master of Public Policy at GraSPP (April or September 2022 enrollee)
- 2. TOEFL iBT 88 or above
- 3. Japanese nationality or Korean nationality with special permanent resident status (other nationalities are subject to consultation\*)

\*\*Since the Campus Asia Program is a CJK-ASEAN student exchange program, we especially encourage participation by Japanese and Korean nationals with special permanent resident status. Students of Chinese nationality are not eligible to apply for the program as they are not permitted to study at Peking University.

# 2. Period of Study Abroad and Options

The following study abroad options which begin in the fall of 2023 or later are available (see Appendix for details)

- Double Degree at Seoul National University (SNUDD)+ Exchange Program at Peking University (PKUEX)
- 2. Double Degree at National University of Singapore (LKYDD) + Exchange Program at Seoul National University or Peking University (SNUEX or PKUEX)
  - Applicants for LKYDD must first pass an on-campus screening for double degree applicants at GraSPP (around November of the year prior to dispatch). After passing the on-campus screening, you will be required to have an interview with a CAMPUS Asia Program faculty member. Please see below for information on how to apply for LKYDD. - 3. Exchange Program at Peking University (PKUEX) + Exchange Program at Seoul National University (SNUEX)

\*\*Double degree (2 semesters) + exchange (1 semester) or exchange (1 semester) + exchange (1 semester).
\*\*First year must be taken at GraSPP and dispatched from the second year onwards. The minimum enrollment period at GraSPP is 2 years and the maximum is 3 years, including the period of study abroad.
\*\*Please contact us individually if you wish to apply for other study abroad options.

Application period: October 15 - October 31, 2022

Interview Date: November 9, 2022 (LKYDD is not included)

Announcement of acceptance: Mid to late November 2022

#### 7. Notes

- Successful applicants will need to submit the following documents to the host universities, please consider preparing as soon as possible. Please note as the procedures may change from year to year, the latest information will be communicated to the students as soon as the host university announces an opening.
  - Recommendation Letters (1 or 2) \*\*SNU has a designated format.
  - Academic Transcripts (Undergraduate and Graduate, in English)
  - Certificate of Highest Degree Attained (Certificate of Undergraduate Diploma or Graduate School Enrollment, in English)
  - Application Form (designated forms)
  - ID Photos
- Successful applicants are required to take the "CAMPUS Asia Joint Course: International Public Policy in East Asia" (2 credits each for S2 and A2). Although it is advised to take the course(s) before studying abroad, please plan according to your own period of study and enrollment.
- Students may not apply concurrently with other study abroad programs.
