About Enforcement of the Research Ethic Education

Based on the guidelines of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, the University of Tokyo has established the Code of Conduct for Research and has been carrying out the research ethic education to all researchers, graduate students and people concerned with administration and management of competitive funds.

Starting from 2015, the Research Ethic Education in GraSPP is enforced in the following cycle:

People who engages in research activities→Once in five years

People concerned with administration and management of competitive funds→ Once in five years

Graduate Students →Once in three years

This year, all graduate students are required to complete the education by either taking the online program (1) (2) or reading the text (3).
