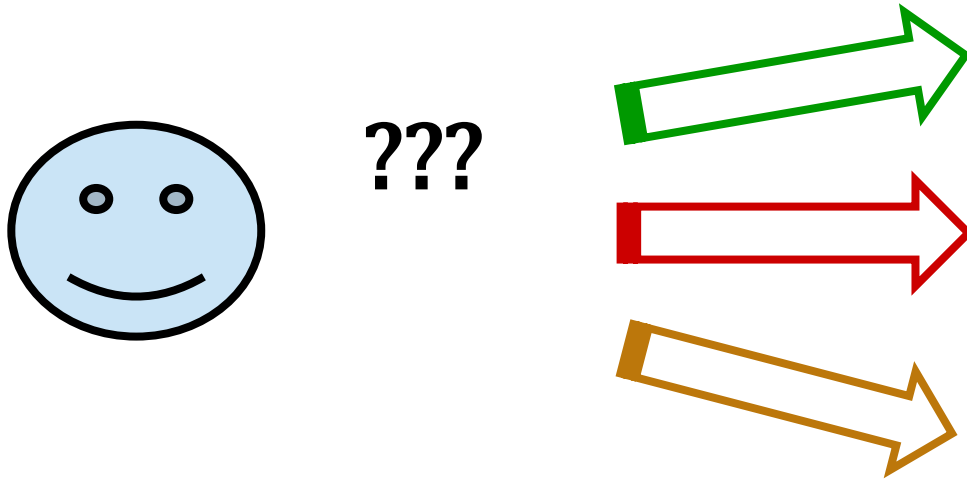

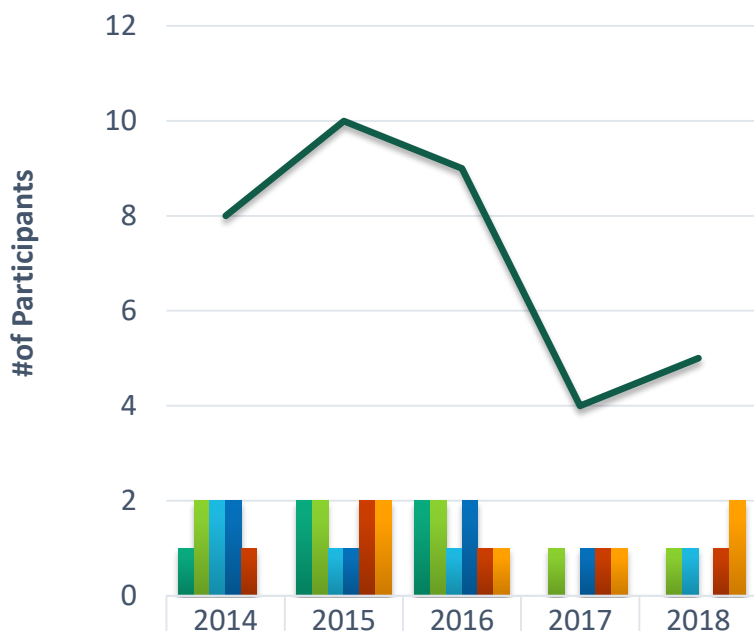

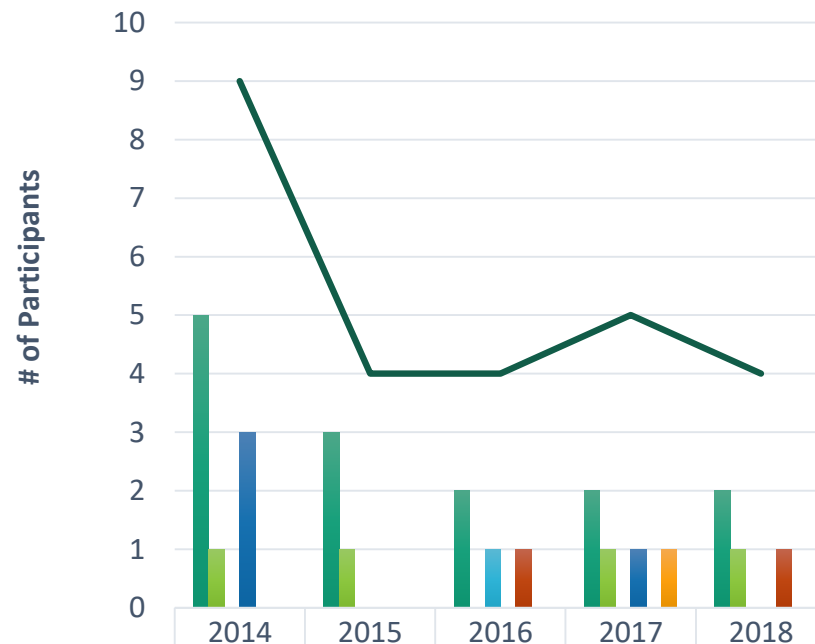

Double Degree Programs

- Can obtain **degrees from both the UTokyo and partner university** upon satisfying the graduation requirements of both degrees.
- A system where a student **works for two different university degrees** in parallel, **completing them in less time (2 to 3 years)** than it would take to earn them separately.

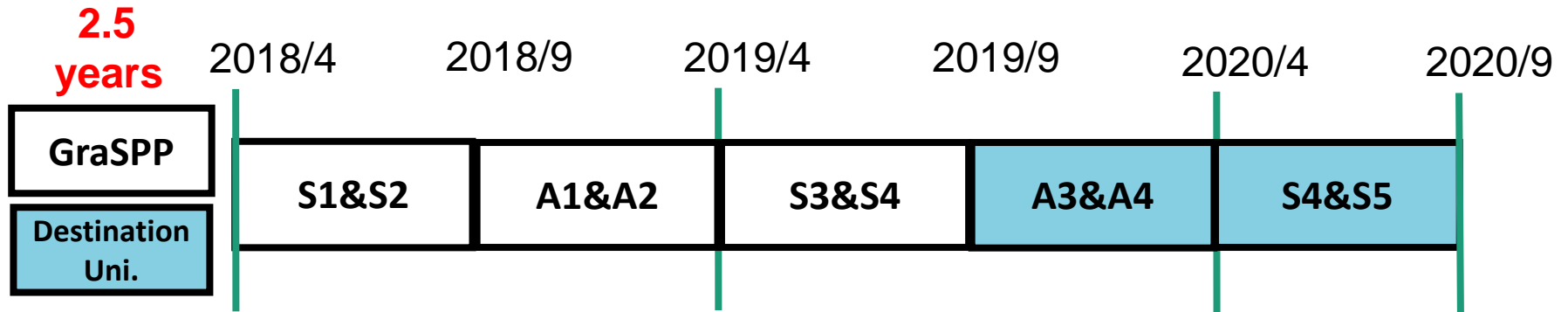

Notes for Double Degree Program ①

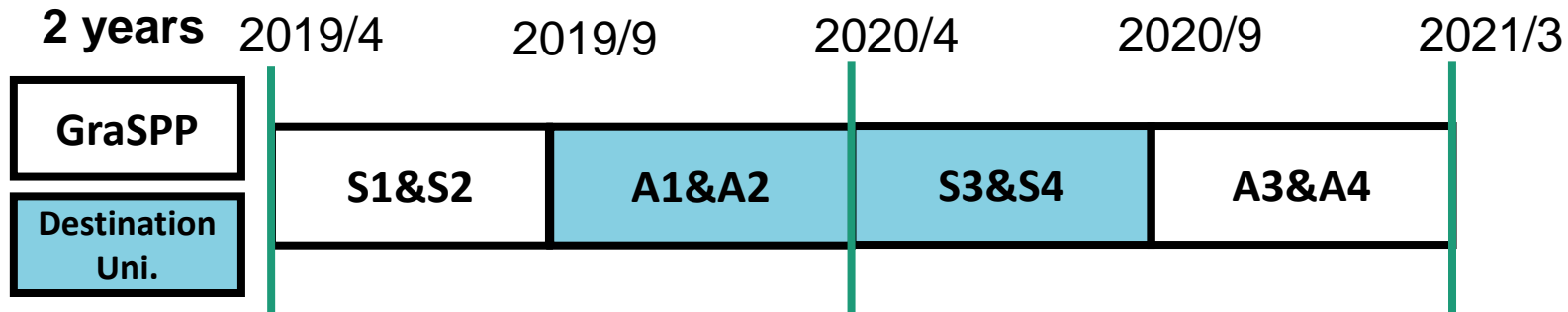
- Recommend to study at GraSPP at least 1 year before departure.
 - Recommend to complete all core courses to meet your graduation requirements of GraSPP before your departure.
 - Recommend to take as many courses taught in English as possible regardless of your current affiliated courses.
- ✎ Sample courses taught in English: Law and Public Policy, International Conflict Study, Micro/Macroeconomics for Public Policy, Statistical Methods, Case Study (事例研究), Econometrics for Public Policy

👉 New system in Sciences Po-GraSPP DD has started in 2016.

- Joint Admission: up to 10 candidates from the world selected jointly by GraSPP and Sciences Po
 - a total of 4 students for 2016-2018 cohort
 - a total of 10 students for 2017-2019 cohort
- Start at Sciences Po in the 1st year, finish the 2nd year at UTokyo (for April enrollees: UTokyo-Sciences Po-UTokyo).

✂️ Application Deadline: **February 8th, 2019**
- Strengthen the bond by maximizing the time together.

Notes for Double Degree Program ③

- ANU, LSE, and HSoG require prospective DD students to attend their program with completed MPP/IP core courses.
⇒ Be prepared to change your affiliated course to IP upon completion of GraSPP nomination (in December).

Preparation FOR HERTIE

- **About School**

- Choose Your Concentration (Policy Analysis / Public Management) and Courses

- If you would like to choose 'Policy Analysis', you need to have a background knowledge of statistics before you come to Hertie.
 - In case of Summer 2017, they have 36 courses and 24 thesis instructors. It is better to check their website and think of which courses/professor you want to choose in advance.

- **Life in Berlin**

- Prepare Documents for Residence Application as Many as Possible (Especially when you do not want to live in a shared house)

- Gehaltsnachweise (Income Certificate), Bank Balance Statement, Schufa-Ankunft, Mietschuldenfreiheitsbescheinigung, etc. All documents are preferably in German.

- Utilize Your Personal Connection

- Connection is really important in any aspects of Berlin life. For instance, joining in a Japanese community may help you search for a residence. Contact your acquaintances in Germany prior to leaving Japan.

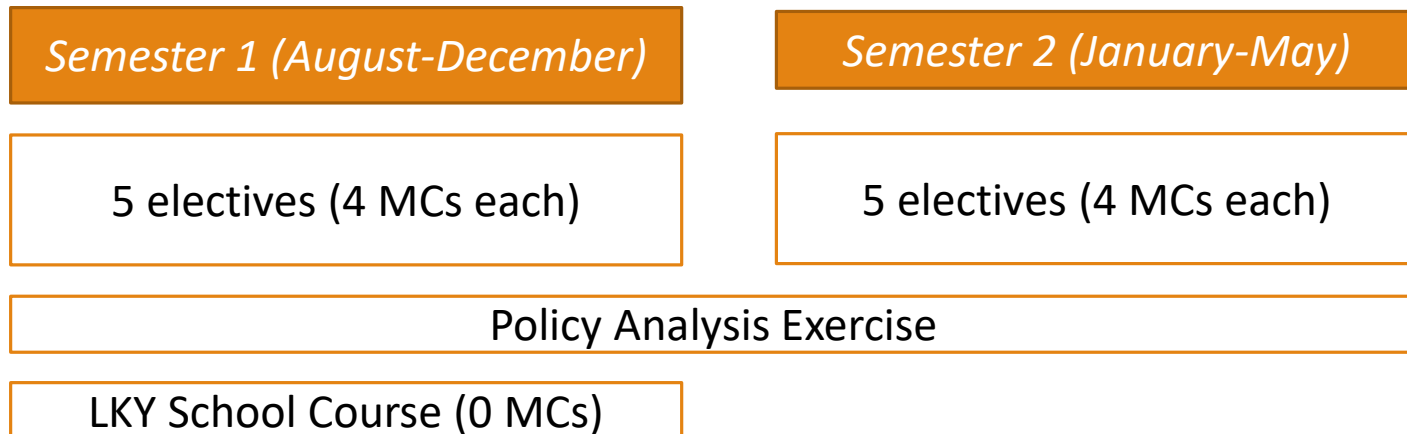

Double Degree Programme Workload Requirements

- Incoming DDP students will be spending **one year** with the School
- DDP students are required to complete at least **44 MCs** (one module is worth 4 MCs), including the 'Policy Analysis Exercise (4 MCs)' and 'LKY School Course (0 MCs)'
- Upon successful completion of the Double Degree Programme (DDP), he/she will be awarded with **two Master Degrees** – one from LKYSPP and another from his/her home university
- A candidate must have obtained a **minimum CAP of 3.00** (average of B-) at the end of the course of study before he/she can be considered for award of the degree of Master in Public Policy

- You must spend a lot of time for preparation

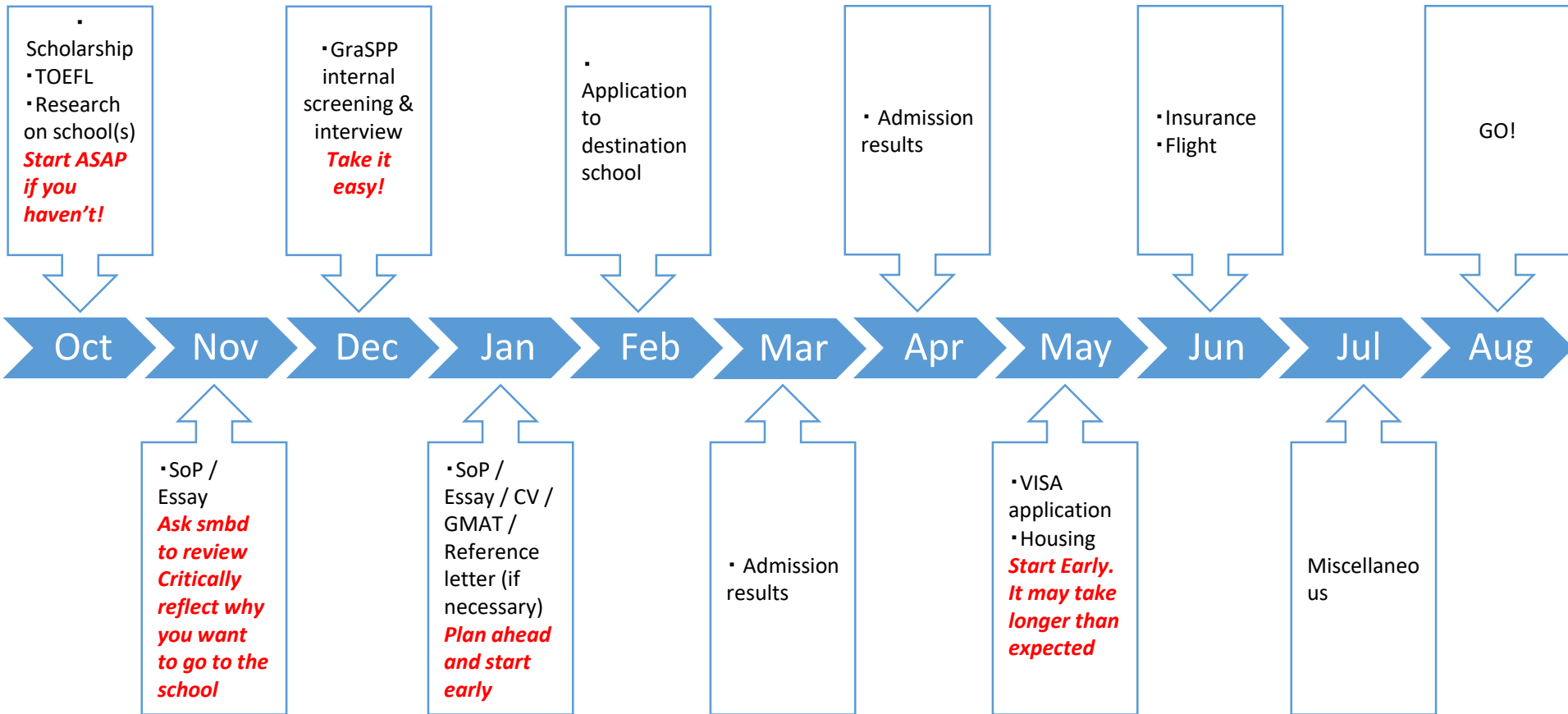
Employment prospect
