Content	The work involves conducting research from within a wide variety of issues and summarizing the research findings, under the guidance of an ERINA researcher specializing in the Chinese or Russian economies.
Eligibility	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The applicant must be a GraSPP international student.</li> <li>2. The applicant must have sufficient skills in English.</li> <li>3. A little knowledge of Japanese is highly appreciated. (No need to be fluent, but if you can understand some simple instructions in Japanese, that will be very much appreciated.)</li> </ol>
Comments from the institution	A student who has a strong interest in the economies of the Northeast Asian region, in particular the Chinese or Russian economies, would be appreciated.
Condition	No remuneration or other financial support will be provided, and therefore the intern will need to pay for their own transportation, accommodation, meals and other expenses. The intern will need to arrange round trip travel between Tokyo and Niigata and they are encouraged to find accommodation in Niigata on their own.
Selection	Interview with faculty members will be arranged later. GraSPP will recommend the shortlisted applicants to the institution for the final selection.
