

Next Calls for Applications Open on January 17, 2022 and March 29, 2022! Graduate Studies Scholarships Available to Developing Country Nationals

The Joint Japan/World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program (JJWBGSP) will take applications from **January 17 to February 28**, **2022** (<u>Application Window #1</u>) and from **March 29 to May 27**, **2022** (<u>Application Window #2</u>). The program is open to women and men from developing countries with professional experience and a history of supporting their countries' development efforts.

## **Applicants Must:**

- Be a national of an <u>eligible developing</u> <u>country;</u>
- Not hold dual citizenship of a developed country;
- Hold a Bachelor (or equivalent) degree earned at least 3 years prior to Application Deadline date;
- Have 3 years or more of recent development-related experience after earning a Bachelor (or equivalent) degree;
- Be accepted unconditionally to enroll in the upcoming academic year in one of the <u>JJWBGSP participating master programs</u> by the Application Deadline Date;
- Not be a staff member (which includes consultants) or relative of a staff member of the World Bank Group.

## Award:

Recipients will receive a full scholarship in development studies to one of the program's preferred masters programs (see the complete list at <u>https://www.worldbank.org/en/programs/scholarships/bri</u> <u>ef/jjwbgsp-participating-programs</u>

Scholarship includes full tuition and fees, a monthly living stipend, round-trip airfare, and travel allowance.

Upon completion of the program, JJWBGSP scholars must immediately return to their home countries to apply their new skills to their countries' social and economic development.
