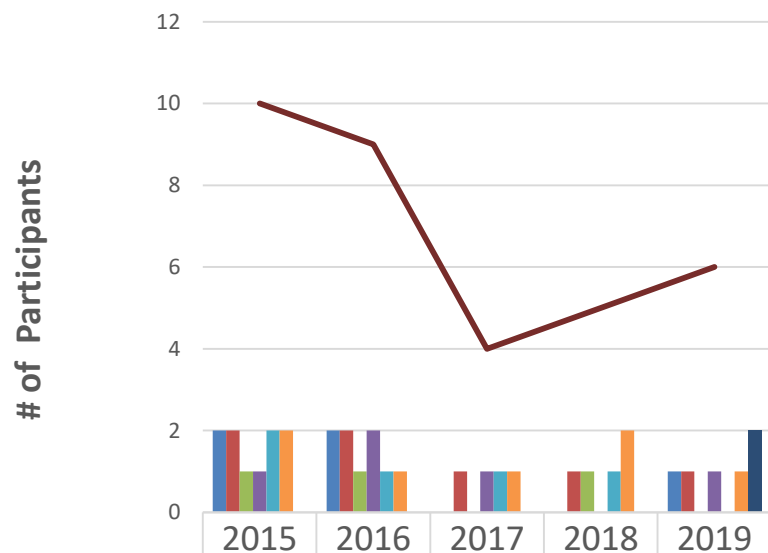

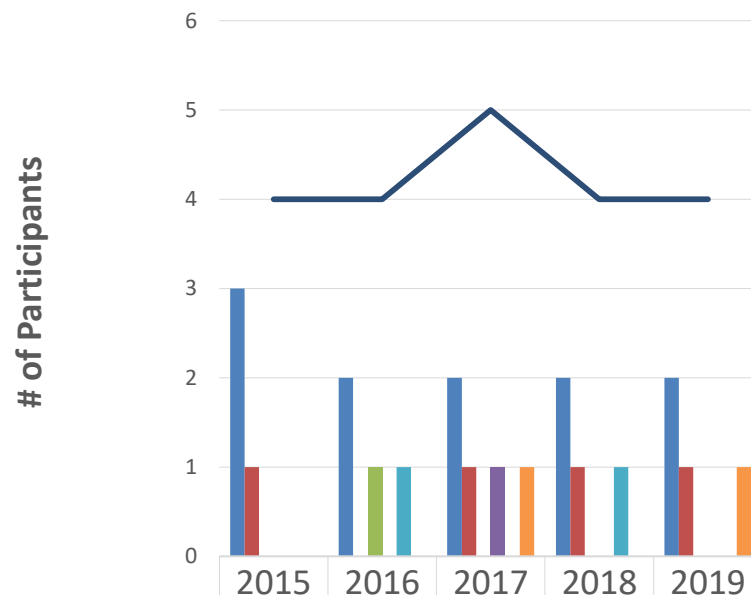

What happened to EX/DD programs for AY 2020?

EX Programs

- Many programs cancelled (e.g. LKY, HEC, UCLA), while some offering online courses (e.g. Sciences Po)
- 2 students sent from GraSPP
- Decent #s of applicants but centered on specific partner school(s)

DD Programs

- ✓ on going program-wize
- ✓ mostly online classes, some "hybrid style"(e.g. SIPA, Hertie, LSE) with closed/Limited access to the campus
- ✓ Less applicants overall and 2 students sent from GraSPP

Double Degree Programs

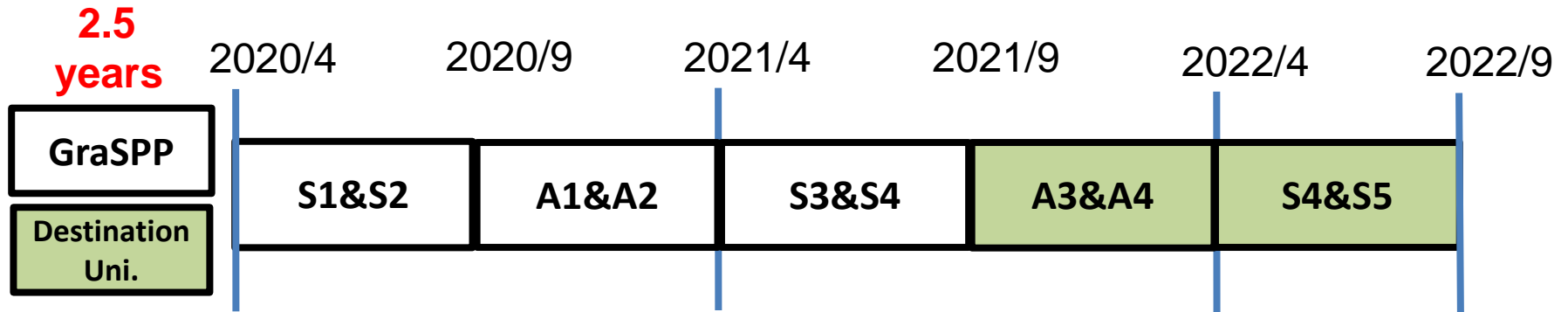
- Can obtain **degrees from both the UTokyo and partner university** upon satisfying the graduation requirements of both degrees.
- A system where a student **works for two different university degrees** in parallel, **completing them in less time (2 to 3 years)** than it would take to earn them separately.

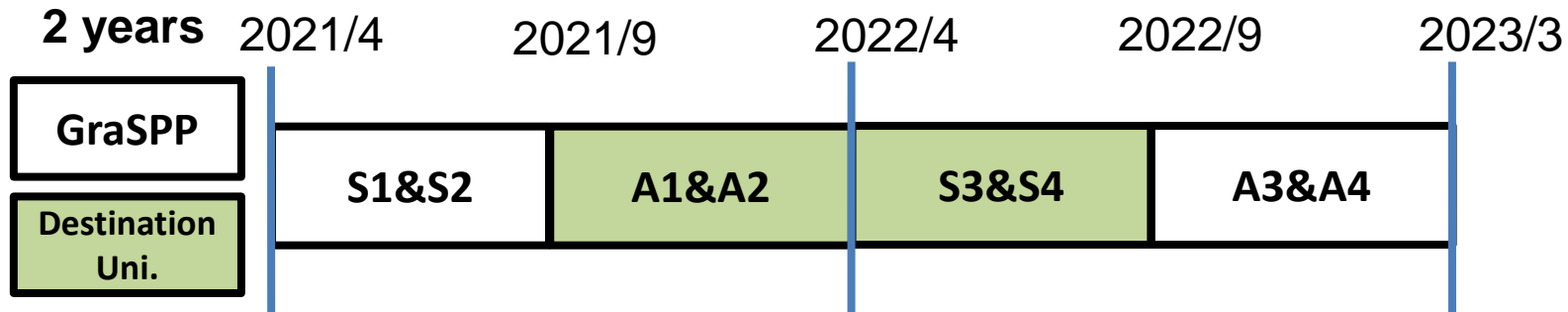

Notes for Double Degree Program ①

- Highly recommend to study at GraSPP at least 1 year before departure.
 - Recommend to complete all core courses to meet your graduation requirements of GraSPP before your departure.
 - Recommend to take as many courses taught in English as possible regardless of your current affiliated courses.
- ✍ Sample courses taught in English: Law and Public Policy, International Conflict Study, Micro/Macroeconomics for Public Policy, Statistical Methods, Case Study (事例研究) , Econometrics for Public Policy

Notes for Double Degree Program ②

- ANU, LSE, and Hertie School require prospective DD students to attend their program with completed MPP/IP core courses.
⇒ Be prepared to change your affiliated course to IP after completion of GraSPP nomination by the time of departure.

My experience at ANU

Reported by Hiroki Takano (starting study at ANU from 2017.7)



Good	
Diversity	The ratio of international students is more than 70%, and they are mainly from Asian countries. They have very different career background including governments, United Nations, NGOs. Discussing with them is very interesting!
Courses	We usually have both lectures and tutorials in each course. The distance between lecturers and students is close, and we always have an active discussion in tutorial. When we miss lectures or want to reconfirm the contents, we can see recorded lectures with our own PC.
Academic Supports	We have easy access to academic skill supports, and academic skill advisors check and correct our drafts of the assignments before we submit to lecturers. There are workshops and opportunities to improve English skills for international students, so I can recommend GraSPP students who have not studied abroad like me to apply for ANU!

Cont'd

Bad	
Workload	The amount of assignment is overwhelming! I have to deal with them on weekdays and weekends, until late at night.
Course selecting	The flexibility of course selecting is not so high due to degree structure and the amount of courses I can attend in a semester (the maximum amount is 4 courses).

Recommended preparation before starting study at ANU

I recommend the students thinking to apply for ANU to get as many credits you can transfer from GraSPP to ANU as possible to expand your choice of course selection.

Year 2 at LSE

- Study + live in London, international hub city of Europe
- Opportunity to choose from 1,300+ postgraduate courses at LSE → Not restricted to MPA courses
- LSE reputation
- Diverse classmates from around the world
- Coursework is demanding! Be prepared for this

Year 2 at LSE - Capstone Project

- The Capstone groups tackle **socially relevant and topical policy issues** and the contribution of MPA students is highly valued by the Capstone clients.
- Students are put into groups of 4–6 for a six-month consultancy style project.
- The Capstone is an excellent opportunity to extend the learnings of Year 1 in the Dual Degree in a professional setting

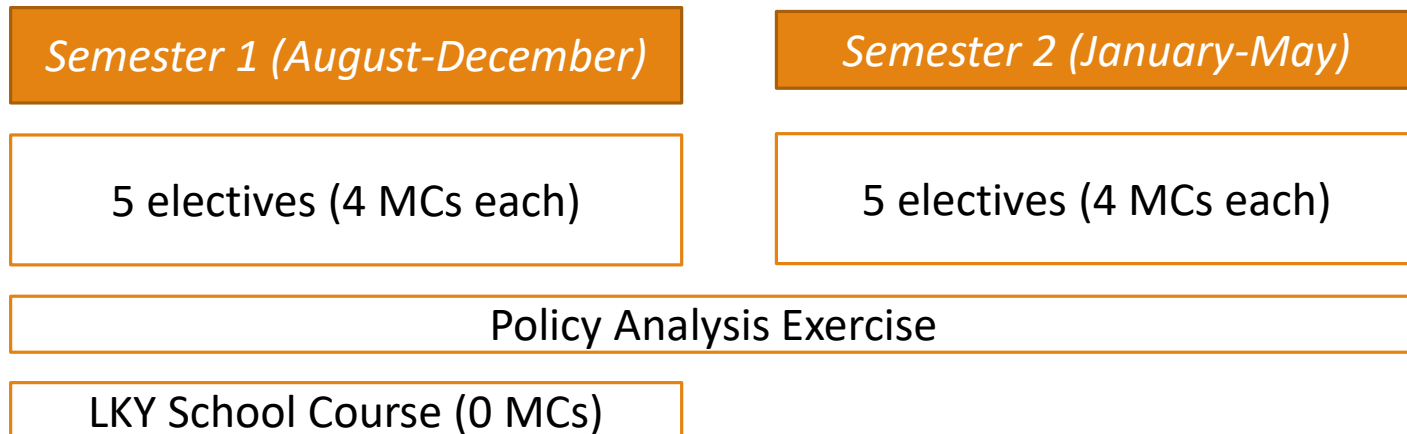

LKY-SPP Double Degree Programme Workload Requirements

- Incoming DDP students will be spending **one year** with the School
- DDP students are required to complete at least **44 MCs** (one module is worth 4 MCs), including the 'Policy Analysis Exercise (4 MCs)' and 'LKY School Course (0 MCs)'
- Upon successful completion of the Double Degree Programme (DDP), he/she will be awarded with **two Master Degrees** – one from LKYSPP and another from his/her home university
- A candidate must have obtained a **minimum CAP of 3.00** (average of B-) at the end of the course of study before he/she can be considered for award of the degree of Master in Public Policy

👉 New system in Sciences Po-GraSPP DD has started in 2016.

- Joint Admission: up to 10 candidates from the world selected jointly by GraSPP and Sciences Po
 - a total of 4 students for 2016-2018 cohort
 - a total of 10 students for 2017-2019 cohort
 - a total of 7 students for 2018-2020 cohort
 - a total of 6 students for 2019-2021 cohort
- Start at Sciences Po in the 1st year, finish the 2nd year at UTokyo (for April enrollees: UTokyo-Sciences Po-UTokyo).
