 - A unit or an individual professional specialized in the topic

4. Submit your note and CV **via ITC-LSM by noon on Friday, June 10, 2022**, as a single PDF file with your name.
5. Any student with temporary enrollment status, if considered by the instructor not ready for preparing and leading discussions with professionals, would be asked to postpone the participation until future occasions.
6. **Only students who have passed the pre-registration screening can register via UTAS by the end of the S2 registration period (June 10-16).**
