Reservations for inoculation with the Omicron-strain matched coronavirus vaccine booster dose will begin from 12:00 on Thursday, 13 October 2022 The following is an overview of the vaccination carried out at the university

1. Date and time

From 31 October – late-December (provisional) Weekdays 09:30 - 09:45 & 16:00 - 16:45There will be no inoculation session on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays Please note that the session may end earlier than stated or the times may change without notice subject to the progress.

2. Venue

Administration Bureau Bldg. No. 2, Hongo Campus, The University of Tokyo (%Please note that the venue is not the Sanjo Conference Hall)

3. Eligibility

Those who are over 18 years old and meet the following criteria are currently eligible (%inoculation is by choice)

 \bigcirc Anyone who falls in any of the following categories (Whether or not you have received the first or second shots of the vaccine is not questioned)

- Students enrolled at the University of Tokyo (UTokyo) (including specially registered students and research students)
- Academic and administrative staff employed by UTokyo (including academic and administrative staff employed at the school attached to the Faculty of Education)
- Visiting faculty, part-time lecturers (including seconded) etc. working at the university
- Researchers who work at UTokyo on a daily basis (including those who do not have the Common IDs)
- · Others who work at UTokyo on a daily basis
- Families, and co-habitants of students, academic and administrative staff of UTokyo

 \bigcirc Those who have received the "booster vaccination" or "vaccination against omicron strains" vaccination voucher sent by the municipality (submission of voucher after the event will not be accepted. Only vaccination vouchers from the municipality you are registered with as resident on the day of the vaccination will be accepted.)

- Those who have been vaccinated two or more times
- Those who have not had their first or second coronavirus vaccinations are recommended to receive the first doses of the conventional vaccine as soon as possible. Please contact your local municipality office for the venue.

You will be able to receive the booster shots if it has been <u>five months or more since</u> your last shot of the vaccination.

If the day after five months does not fall on a day the workplace vaccination, you will be able to receive the vaccination on the subsequently available date for the workplace vaccination.

 - (3) Student or Staff ID (for those working at the university without an UTokyo ID, an official ID)
