2. Search the organization's website to identify a topic of your interest and find a unit or an individual professional specialized in the topic.
3. Write two short proposals (up to 300 words for each) defining an issue to be discussed under the overarching topic of "Geo-economic challenges for sustainable, resilient, and inclusive Asia."
4. Submit your proposals and CV **via ITC-LMS by Friday, June 2, 2023, as a single PDF file with your student ID number in its title.**
5. Students with temporary enrollment status, if considered by the instructor not ready for preparing and leading discussions with professionals, would be asked to postpone participation until future occasions.
6. **Only students who have passed the pre-registration screening can register via UTAS by the end of the S2 registration period (June 12-16).**
7. Please do not count credits for this course to satisfy your completion requirements if you plan to graduate in September 2023.
