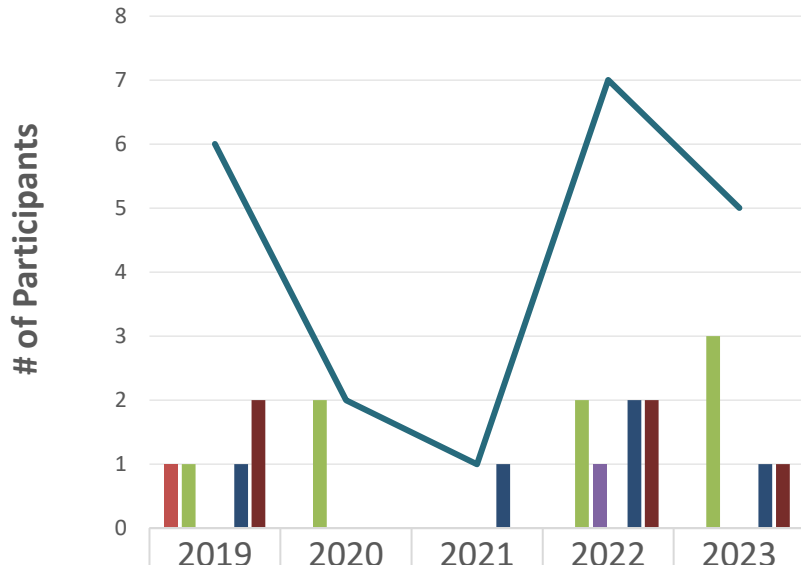

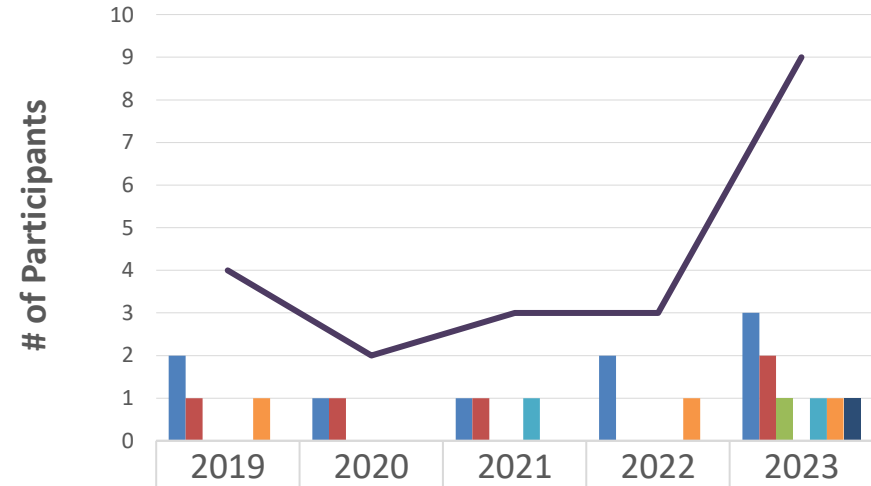

Double Degree Programs

- Can obtain **degrees from both the UTokyo and partner university** upon satisfying the graduation requirements of both degrees.
- A system where a student **works for two different university degrees** in parallel, **completing them in less time (2 to 3 years)** than it would take to earn them separately.

Fairly New Double Degree Program with King's College London

KCL is a major research university in the UK, located in a heart of London.

The Department of War Studies (DWS) is one of the only academic departments in the world focused on understanding the complex realm of conflict, security, and international politics through inter-disciplinary teaching, research and engagement

Key Features:

This is a one-way program starting at GraSPP (1st year) and finish up at KCL (2nd year).

There are 12 Programmes/Majors (e.g. MA Cyber Policy and Strategy, MA Conflict, Security & Development, MA International Relations, MA Science & International Security, etc) to choose from.

Completion of all the course work and dissertation at KCL is required.

*No credit transferring from GraSPP to KCL; credits earned at KCL can be brought back to GraSPP.

Completion of the core courses and case studies according to the requirements of your programs at GraSPP before departure is required.

Notes for Double Degree Program

- Highly recommend to study at GraSPP at least 1 year before departure.
- Recommend to complete all core/compulsory courses to meet your graduation requirements of GraSPP before your departure.
- Recommend to take as many courses taught in English as possible regardless of your current affiliated courses.

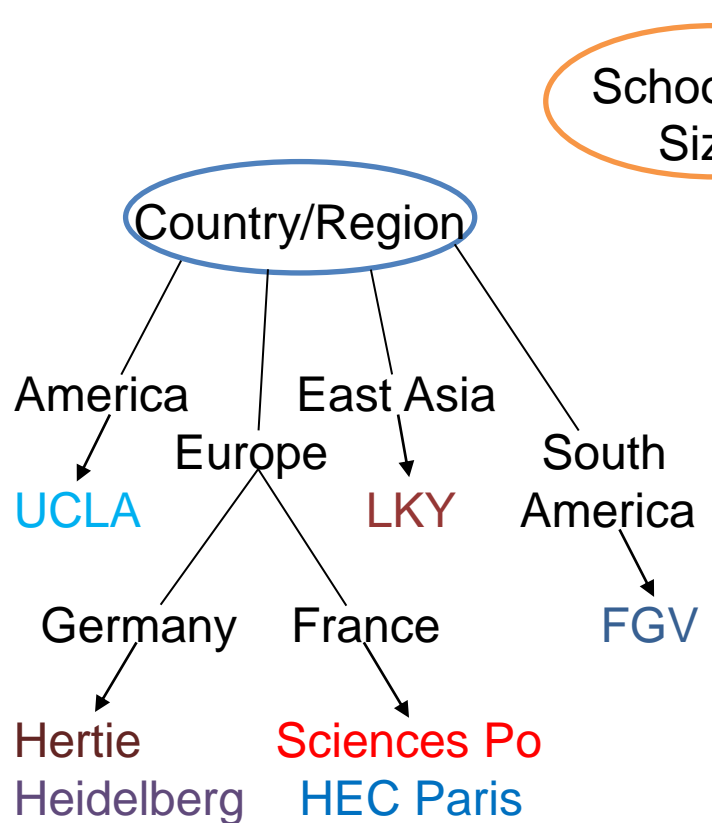

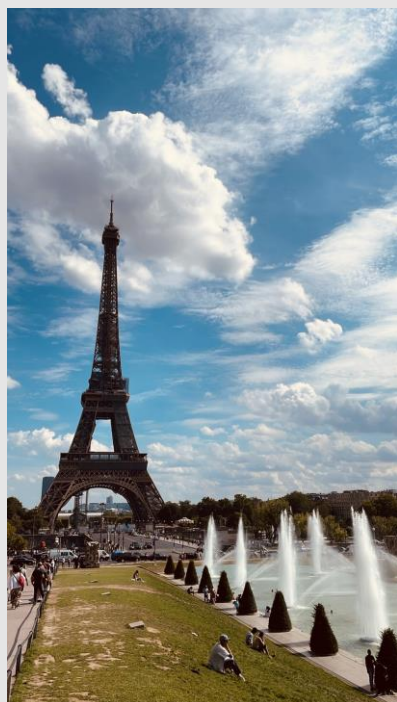
