

GraSPP Job-Type (GJT) Scholarship for doctoral students

"GraSPP Job-Type (GJT) Scholarship for doctoral students" aims at providing a research grant with research assistant (RA) jobs to high-achieving students who are privately-funded to assist their academic pursuits at the University.

Eligibility	<p>Full-time doctoral students enrolled in the GraSPP doctoral program</p> <p>* If either one of the following applies to you, you are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recipients of the JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists - Government or scholarship organization-sponsored international students - Those who are financially supported by any program for Leading Graduate Schools or World-leading Innovative Graduate Study Program - Those who are financially supported by the Fostering Advanced Human Resources to Lead Green Transformation (GX) project - Recipients of The University of Tokyo Fellowship - Those who have an occupation and earn income
Duration	Standard doctoral program duration (up to three years)
Monthly Stipend	<p>1st year: 150,000JPY 2nd and 3rd year: 200,000JPY</p> <p>* GJT scholarship students are required to apply for the JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists(DC) and the Fostering Advanced Human Resources to Lead Green Transformation (GX) project (SPRING GX).</p> <p>* They must also pass the "Financial Support Screening" at the end of the 1st year.</p>
Responsibilities	<p>GJT scholarship students are required to contribute to the successful implementation of the following in collaboration with faculty members and staff in charge.</p> <p>Expected work includes but is not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>RA-type jobs</i> - <i>Organizing seminars and other events</i> - <i>Other related work</i> <p>Also, a job report must be submitted to the GraSPP Graduate School Office every month.</p>
Annual Intake	A shortlist of selected students
Selection Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Those who wish to apply for the GJT scholarship must complete the scholarship section through the Web Application System. 2. The GraSPP Doctoral Admission Committee selects scholarship recipients based on application documents. 3. Applicants will receive the scholarship selection result and the final admission result simultaneously.
