

Double Degree Programs

- Can obtain degrees from both the UTokyo and partner university upon satisfying the graduation requirements of both degrees.
- A system where a student works for two different university degrees in parallel, completing them in less time (2 to 3 years) than it would take to earn them separately.

Notes for Double Degree Programs

- Highly recommend to study at GraSPP at least 1 year before departure.
- Recommend to complete all core/compulsory courses to meet your graduation requirements of GraSPP before your departure.
- Recommend to take as many courses taught in English as possible regardless of your current affiliated courses.

Notes for Double Degree Program 2

- ANU, LSE, and Hertie School <u>require</u> prospective DD students to attend their program with completed MPP/IP core courses.
 - ⇒Be prepared to change your affiliated course to IP after completion of GraSPP nomination by the time of departure.



- ✓ Must take 5112250 Introduction to Social Sciences during their 1st year at GraSPP
- ✓ TOEFL iBT 90 (≥ 20 in Reading and Writing and ≥18 in Speaking and Listening or IELTS 6.5 (≥6.0 in each section)



- ✓ TOEFL iBT 100 (≥25 in R; ≥24 in WR and ≥22 in other areas) or IELTS 7.0 (≥7.0 in Reading and ≥6.5 in other sections)
- ✓ All required core courses and at least 24 credits, including 4 Case Studies credits, completed by end of 1st year

IIIII Hertie School

- ✓ MPP/IP student preferred
- ✓ At least TOEFL iBT 100
- ✓1st year core courses required by MPP/IP completed
- ✓ Master Thesis (~12,000 words) is required


