

## GraSPP CAMPUS Asia Plus

# Application Guidelines

### Important Notice

The current CAMPUS Asia Mode 3 program (a project subsidized by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) will end in March 2026. After a selection period of about seven to eight months, the program will transition to Mode 4 if it is successfully selected. The details of our university's initiatives under Mode 4 have not yet been decided.

Regardless of whether the program is selected or not, studying abroad at partner universities (both DD and Ex) will remain possible under the existing agreements. However, please apply with full understanding that the content of the program and the financial support currently provided under CAMPUS Asia may change without notice.

## 1. Eligibility

1. Students enrolled in Master of Public Policy at GraSPP, or scheduled to be enrolled from April or September 2026
2. Japanese nationality or Korean nationality with special permanent resident status (other nationalities are subject to consultation※)

※ Since the CAMPUS Asia Program is a CJK-ASEAN student exchange program, we especially encourage participation by Japanese and Korean nationals with special permanent resident status. Students of Chinese nationality are not eligible to study at Peking University.

## 2. Period of Study Abroad and Options

- ① **Basic options:** Double Degree (2 semesters) + Exchange (1 semester), or Exchange (1 semester) + Exchange (1 semester).
- ② Students will study at GraSPP in their first year and go abroad from the second year onward. The period of enrollment at GraSPP, including the study-abroad period, will be a minimum of 2 years and a maximum of 3 years.
- ③ **Applicants enrolling in October 2025 may apply for the Peking University Double Degree only if they extend their enrollment to 3 years. Applications will be accepted in February 2026.**
- ④ From the fall 2026 dispatch onward, it will also be possible to choose only a single Double Degree with one partner university or only an Exchange option. However, since students choosing the basic options will be given priority, these alternatives will be available only if there are remaining slots.
- ⑤ Please note that students with Chinese nationality are not permitted to study abroad at Peking University (for both DD and EX).
- ⑥ **Concurrent applications to CAMPUS Asia and other study-abroad programs are not allowed.**

### 3. Financial Support

1. Scholarship through the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) Overseas Study Support Program  
※There are various conditions for receiving this benefit, such as nationality, academic performance standards, and infectious disease risk level. It is also subject to change from year to year. This scholarship is granted only while studying at the host university on site (taking courses online is not applicable). Details will be provided to eligible participants.
2. Dormitories provided by the host university (except LKY)
3. Tuition waiver at the host university (except LKYDD)

**※Important: Please note that the above financial support will apply to study abroad programs that begin by the end of March 2026 under the current Mode 3; it has not yet been determined whether the same support will continue for study abroad programs that begin in April 2027 or later.**

- ◆ Successful applicants will need to submit the following documents to the host universities, please consider preparing as soon as possible. Please note as the procedures may change from year to year, the latest information will be communicated to the students as soon as the host university announces an opening.
  - Recommendation Letters (1 or 2) ※SNU has a designated format.
  - Academic Transcripts (Undergraduate and Graduate, in English)
  - Certificate of Highest Degree Attained (Certificate of Undergraduate Diploma or Graduate School Enrollment, in English)
  - Application Form (designated forms)
  - ID Photos

※The final decision on whether or not to accept a student for study abroad is left to each host university.

- ◆ Students who pass the selection process at GraSPP will join the program as CAMPUS Asia students and are required to take the "CAMPUS Asia Joint Course: International Public Policy in East Asia" (2 credits each for S and A semester). Although it is advised to take the course(s) before studying abroad, please plan according to your own period of study and enrollment.

Features	Peking University is one of the first national key universities established in 1898 as a national university. As China's premier institution of higher learning, it has produced many politicians and scientists. It is also adjacent to Zhongguancun, China's Silicon Valley, where numerous IT industries and research centers are located. The School of International Studies accepts students with a solid foundation in their undergraduate major and a desire to actively study Chinese diplomacy and international relations. The "Master of International Relations" course, to which students studying abroad under the CAMPUS Asia program belong, is small, with a maximum of 20 students per academic year, and combines theory and practice, allowing students to learn in English about politics, diplomacy, and social development in modern China in depth. It is also possible to earn a master's degree from Peking University if you fulfill the requirements for earning the required credits, writing a research paper, and passing an oral examination.
